



2020-2021 Standard Dress List

At Iduma Elementary we strive to focus on the student as a unique individual. We believe standard dress encourages us to focus on the worth of our students without the distraction of judgment of others. It allows us to achieve our goal of being active, compassionate, life-long learners who understand other people and their differences. By adopting a standard dress policy our staff and students can focus on learning at hand.

Shirts: Plain, polo style; short or long sleeved.

- **Colors: red, white, navy blue only**
- No logos (except Friday spirit shirts, see below)
- Shirts do not have to be tucked in but must be the appropriate size for the child

Pants: May be cargo, capri length, or shorts of appropriate length as stated in the KISD Student Code of Conduct.

- **Colors: Khaki, navy, or black.**
- Must be appropriately sized or worn with a belt.

Skirts and Jumpers: Girls may wear skirts and jumpers that are **khaki, navy or black**. Girls need to wear a standard dress shirt underneath the jumper. The articles of clothing must also be appropriate length as stated in the KISD Student Code of Conduct.

Undershirts: If worn, they must be tucked in and may be **red, white, or navy blue, or black**.

Leggings/Socks: Solid standard dress colors only (**red, white, navy, black, or khaki**), **no designs and matching colors**.

Jackets: Jackets **worn in the building** must be solid colors with no logos or embellishments. Acceptable colors are **red, white, or navy blue, and/or black**.

Shoes: Athletic shoes with socks are required *every* day. (TOMS, BOBS, Sperry's or boat shoes are **not** considered athletic shoes)

Friday Dress: School spirit shirts may be worn with black or blue jeans (no holes/rips) or standard dress pants/shorts. **Jeans may have designs or embellishments on the pockets only and may only be worn with a spirit shirt**. Students may also wear the regular standard dress.
