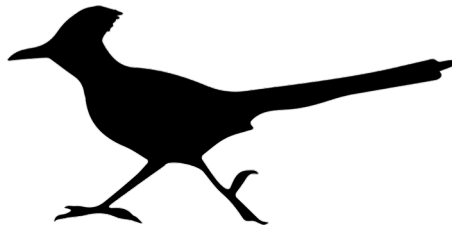
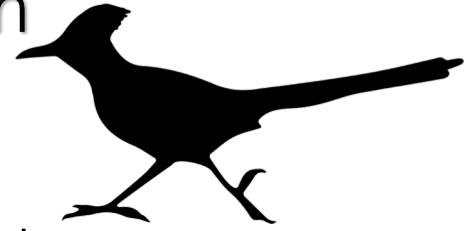

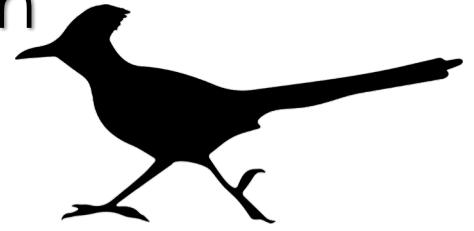

MAKER SPACE CLUB – 3rd, 4th, & 5th grades

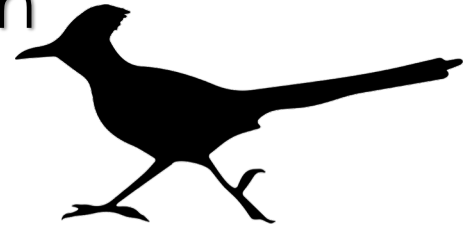
